1. Why do I need this medicine ?

Treatment or prophylaxis for certain types of ventricular arrhythmia

2. Before taking Codarone, what do I need to tell the doctor?

(1) If you are allergic to amiodarone, iodine, or any of the ingredients in Cordarone tablets.

(2) If you are under thyroid disease.

(3) If you are having surgery, including dental surgery.

(4) If you are pregnant, plan to become pregnant, or breastfeeding.

(5) If you are taking other medicines at the same time, make sure to inform your doctor or pharmacist in order to avoid drug interactions

3. What information should I know about this medicine?

(1) Avoid unnecessary or prolonged exposure to sunlight and to wear protective clothing, sunglasses, and sunscreen. Amiodarone may make your skin sensitive to sunlight.

(2) If you experience any of the following symptoms, call your doctor immediately: shortness of breath, dyspnea, dry cough, unusual tiredness, fever, diarrhea, wight loss, muscle pain, blurred vision, or recurrent palpitation.

(3) Before any surgery, please inform your doctor or dentist that you are taking Cordarone.

(4) Take regular blood tests for thyroid and liver function check-ups.



4. Possible Side Effects

If you have the following conditions after taking the medicine, please inform your doctor: fatigue, tremor, numbness, vomiting, constipation, loss of appetite, blurred vision, sensitivity of the skin.

If you have the following conditions during medication, please contact your doctor immediately: chest pain, shortness of breath(especially when exercising),

tachycardia or arrhythmia.

5. What should I do if I forget to take my medication?

(1) If you found that you forget to take your medication, please take the medication as soon as you remember.

(2) If it is already close to the time for next dose, please skip this one dose, and take the next dose of medication on time.

(3) Remember not to take double dosing in a single medication intake.

6. Storage and Stability

- (1) Store the medicine at room temperature, avoid heat or moisture.
- (2) Keep out of the reach of children.
- (3) Discard expired medication.
