1. Why do I need this medicine?

Treatment for hyperkalemia associated with renal failure.

2. How is this drug best taken?

- (1) Oral administration: Mix with 30-50 ml of cold water and swallow it.
- (2) Rectal administration: Mix with 100 ml of warm water (body temperature), administer as an enema, and retain it in the intestine for 30-60 minutes. If there is leakage of the solution, elevate the hips by placing a pillow underneath or adopt the knee-chest position.

3. What are some things I need to know or do while I take this drug?

If you experience any gastrointestinal symptoms such as severe constipation, persistent abdominal pain, or vomiting, stop taking the drug and seek medical attention immediately.

4. Possible side effects

Constipation, loss of appetite, nausea and vomiting.

5. What do I do if I miss a dose?

Take it as soon as you remember. If it's close to your next dose, skip the missed one and continue with your regular schedule. Do not use 2 doses at the same time and be sure to inform your doctor.

6. How do I store this drug?

Store in a cool and dry place at room temperature. Keep away from direct sunlight and out of reach of children.
