1. Why do I need this medicine?

Paxloid is an antiviral medicine used to treat mild to moderate COVID-19 pneumonia within 5 days of onset.

2. How should this medicine be used?

- ①Use it in the morning and evening for five consecutive days.
- ②Please follow the doctor's instructions to take the medication on time and complete the course of treatment. Do not increase or decrease the dosage or change the way of use, otherwise it may affect the therapeutic effect.

- 3 Can be taken with or without food, swallow the whole tablet do not chew or crush it.
- ① If you are unable to swallow the medicine orally, please discuss with your doctor and pharmacist for other treatment options.

3. Other Medication Precautions

- ①This medicine is not approved for use in patients younger than 12 years old or body weight less than 40 kg.
- ② If you have liver or kidney disease, please inform your doctor and pharmacist to evaluate the dosage and suitability of the medicine.
- ③Paxlovid may cause potential drug interactions with many drugs. If you are using the following drugs, please contact your doctor

The following drugs cannot be used with Paxlovid:

- α_1 adrenoreceptors antagonist : alfuzosin
- Analgesics: pethidine · piroxicam · propoxyphene
- Anti-anginal drugs: ranolazine
- Antiarrhythmic drug: amiodarone \ dronedarone \ flecainide \ propafenone \ quinidine
- Anti-gout drugs: colchicine
- Antipsychotic drugs: lurasidone pimozide clozapine
- Ergot derivatives: dihydroergotamine ergotamine methylergonovine
- HMG-CoA reductase inhibitors: lovastatin simvastatin
- Pulmonary hypertension drugs: sildenafil

- Sedative drugs: triazolam midazolam
- Anticancer drugs : apalutamide
- Anticonvulsant : carbamazepine · phenobarbital · phenytoin
- Anti-tuberculosis drugs: rifampin
- Hearb: St John's Wort

① If you are pregnant or breastfeeding, please discuss with your healthcare provider.

4. Possible side effects

- ①Loss of appetite, yellowing of your skin and the whites of eyes (jaundice), dark-colored urine, pale colored stools and itchy skin, stomach area (abdominal) pain, altered sense of taste, diarrhea, high blood pressure and muscle aches.
- ②Resistance to HIV Medicines. If you have untreated HIV infection, PAXLOVID may lead to some HIV medicines not working as well in the future.

5. What to do if you forget to take your medicine

- ①Within 8 hours from the missed dose, please take the medicine as soon as you remember.
- ②If more than 8 hours have elapsed since the missed dose, please skip the missed dose and take the medicine at the next scheduled time. Do not take double doses.

6. Storage and Stability

- ①Store the medicine in a closed container at room temperature
- ²Keep away from heat, moisture, and direct light.
